After verification by this Housing Agency, the information will be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development on Form HUD-50058 (Tenant Data Summary). See the Privacy Act Notice for more information about its use. The income that you report to your Section 8 office will also be matched against the income that is collected through computer matching agreements under HUD’s EIV system. If there are substantial discrepancies between what your reported income and what the HUD EIV system contains, you will be required to repay the program for underreporting of income and/or it may cause you to lose your Section 8 benefits.
